



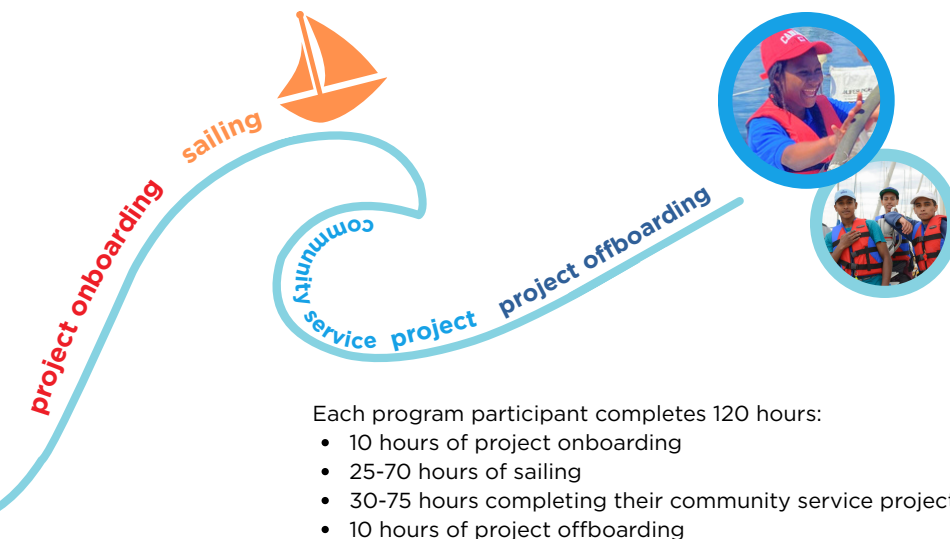

Our **Ships2Shores** program directly engages these youth in sailing and tall ship voyages, fostering knowledge, skills, and a sense of belonging, while giving back to the community through meaningful volunteer service projects.

TO 61,000+ HOURS OF VOLUNTEER COMMUNITY SERVICE**



Each program participant completes 120 hours:

- 10 hours of project onboarding
- 25-70 hours of sailing
- 30-75 hours completing their community service project
- 10 hours of project offboarding

70%+ of participants are young women, newcomers, and members of BIPOC and 2SLGTBQ+ communities.
