### Saturday, June 6 – Sunday, June 7 - Tall Ship Training Weekend

**Arrival:** 0600h on Saturday, June 6 at The Ship (Bus Departure @ 0630h sharp)

**Pickup:** 2030h on Sunday, June 7 at The Ship

- Cadets will be training at HMCS Star and aboard the Brigs Tall Ships.
  - This is an OVERNIGHT activity.
- **Only cadets who signed up are able to attend this activity.**
- Cadets must eat breakfast before arriving on Saturday morning, all other meals provided.
- Cadets should pack a day bag with items required during the day and a separate overnight bag for the weekend.
- **Parents must come into the Ship during drop-off to sign required training waivers.**
- A separate handout with additional information has been distributed.
- Cadets only wishing to attend one day will require their parents to pickup/dropoff at HMCS Star.

### Tuesday, June 9 – Final ACR Practice

- This will be the final opportunity to have uniforms inspected, badges sewn on, and any required uniform parts requested from Supply prior to ACR.

- Cadets must eat breakfast before arriving, Lunch is provided.
  - Selections will be made on June 8 and cadets will be informed which day they have been assigned.

- A final participant list and detailed handout will be distributed on June 9.
  - **Only cadets who sign up and are selected will be able to attend.**
